Other options for adopting or placing a cat: Check references when placing a cat – ask for a vet and personal references; ask for adoption fee.

When adopting a cat: ask for the cat's medical history and records.

www.petfinder.com: Post pictures & info of cats needing homes; can look for pets by location & type/breed

Tulsa World newspaper: Run an ad; charge an adoption fee to screen out questionable adopters

Vet Offices: They sometimes take kittens and adopt them to good homes or you can post flyers of cats needing homes

Southern Agriculture and related stores: Can post flyers of cats needing homes

Barns: Some people take in cats to help keep the rodent population down, but be sure they also provide cat food and water for them and keep them in a barn or enclosure for a couple weeks so they don't run away until they are used to the new home
